FDOT Basic Safety Certification Course

Target Audience: This ½ day FDOT certification course is designed to train **new flagger personnel** to provide safe passage of traffic through and around work areas and to minimize confusion through knowledge and implementation of standard flagging procedures. This course is recommended for personnel who close traffic lanes for construction work and/or perform emergency lane closures. The course is also recommended for **experienced flaggers** who need FDOT **recertification** which is **required every 4 years**.
